2010 GREAT LAKES MARITIME EDUCATION WORKSHOP APPLICATION

The 2010 Great Lakes Maritime Education Workshop will be held July 14^h through 18th at the St. Helena Island Light Station. The workshop site is located 6 miles west of the Mackinac Bridge on St. Helena Island, in northern Lake Michigan. Participants will be immersed in a breathtaking, living history experience as the story of the Great Lakes comes alive in a lighthouse on the shores of this uninhabited Michigan Island.

The cross curricular lessons are aligned to Michigan's Standards, Benchmarks, and GLCES (grade level content expectations). Presentations include hands-on Great Lakes activities to share with students in the following content areas: lake transportation, freighters, water flow, ecology, technology, historic role playing, maritime history, cities/ports, geology, and music and dancing.

The workshop fee is \$275.00, due with your application, which partially pays for educational materials, food, and housing at the light station. The Great Lakes Lighthouse Keepers Association will subsidize the majority of the rest of the cost, including boat transportation out of Mackinaw City, Michigan to and from St. Helena Island. Placement in the workshop will be on a first come-first served basis. The workshop size is limited to 12 to 15 students.

For additional fees, Central Michigan University will offer 2 graduate credit hours and the Eastern UP ISD will offer 2.7 SB-CEUs.
